We want to pray for a strong and growing church in Raleigh whose members are Montagnards (mone-tan-yards) from Vietnam. And we especially want to pray for **Chau** (choe) **Cil** (seal), the pastor and church planter who we support through our church’s Cooperative Program giving.

Years ago, the Montagnards were mostly farmers who lived in villages in the highlands of Vietnam. They had their own language and culture. They endured heavy persecution, and thousands were killed during the war when the United States fought the communist government in Vietnam. (The Montagnards sided with the U.S. in the war, by the way.)

Many of these people have come to America to live and have been adjusting to a different way of life. One man in the church was a farmer back in Vietnam. Now he works for a printing company. Chau Cil also works at a tech firm in the Research Triangle Park, in addition to his church ministry.

Today, let us thank the Lord that this strong new church is doing so well, and let us pray that our missionary, Chau Cil, will stay strong as he leads them to grow in faith and in numbers.
