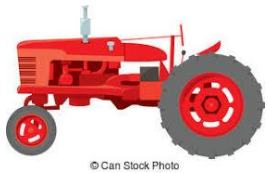

We know there are now many Hispanics living in North Carolina — and they are a big missions challenge for our churches.

Baptists have started nearly 200 Hispanic Baptist churches, but many more are needed.

That brings us to **Barry Matos** (MATT-ose), our Spanish-speaking missionary we are going to pray for today. Barry has started a thriving Hispanic church in Kannapolis. Our church is a part of this because we help support Barry through our Cooperative Program giving.

In English, the name of the church is “Disciples of Christ Baptist Church,” because discipleship and Christian growth are central to the church’s beliefs.

He and the members did a lot of work on a storefront building on Cannon Boulevard to convert it to a church building.

The building does not have a baptistry, of course, so when they baptize new believers, they heat water in the back, pour it into a portable tank and wheel it into the sanctuary. Many of our new churches use portable baptistries like this.

Today let’s pray for Barry Matos and the important ministry he is doing in Kannapolis. Let’s pray that this church will grow and start other churches to reach the hundreds of thousands of Hispanics who now call our state home.
