Article III – Statement of Faith

This church is a congregation of baptized believers in Christ, voluntarily united for the worship of God. It is associated in the faith and fellowship of the gospel to practice its precepts, to receive, and to faithfully recommend to all people, Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. We believe the Holy Bible is inspired by God and faithfully bears witness to Jesus Christ and His timeless message of mercy, forgiveness, and hope for humanity. We believe the Bible reveals God’s nature and purpose and, therefore, serves as our guide for faith, practice, and conduct. We believe God speaks through Scripture to each generation; and, therefore, we trust the Holy Spirit to guide us as we read and interpret the Bible. We embrace the idea of the *Priesthood of the believer*, which grants every Christian the right to read and interpret the Bible as he/she is led by the Holy Spirit. We also believe in the *soul’s competency before God* in that each person has the ability, the freedom, and the responsibility to discover God’s will and purpose for his/her life, without the requirement of a priest or intermediary, except for Jesus our Savior, the one who provides reconciliation between God and man.

The church subscribes to the doctrinal statement of the Baptist Faith and Message as adopted by the Southern Baptist Convention in 1963. We reject any human creeds and denominational structures that seek to coerce, conform, and constrain beliefs or practices.
