Schedule for Deacons Election 2018-2019

1. Sunday, July 22, 2018

Church members will write the name of their five (5) nominees on specially prepared sheets. Persons whose names are submitted will be notified by letter during the week. They will be asked to respond by indicating their willingness to serve if elected. If two or more persons from the same household are nominated, then all but one must remove his/her name(s) from the list of nominees.

2. Sunday, August 5, 2018

A list of all nominees willing to serve will be presented to the church as information in preparation for the vote on Sunday, August 12th.

3. Sunday, August 12, 2018

A ballot containing the nominees' names will be given to the church. Each member will be asked to vote for five (5). The five (5) persons receiving the highest number of votes will be declared duly elected Deacons.

4. Sunday, August 19, 2018

Ordination of new Deacons, if required, will take place during the Evening Worship Hour. Deacons Meeting immediately following service.

Qualifications and Number of Deacons

Deacons shall have been resident lay members of the church for at least two years at the time of selection, be at least twenty-one years of age, meet spiritual qualifications modeled on the teachings and example of Jesus, and be willing to participate in and support the total church program. The number of deacons shall be 15 and shall not exceed the ratio of one deacon for each 25 households represented among the resident membership. A deacon may serve as chairman on only one standing committee.
