Due to the ongoing "COVID-19 effect", there will be several changes to the way in which Sunday Morning Worship will be both carried out and attended:

1. The service will be shortened due to some elements of the service being omitted (no congregational singing, no offering time during the service). The average service will be about 30 minutes.
2. To enter any of the buildings on Sunday requires a temperature check, at which time you will be given a Sticker that you will receive at one of the following locations: FLC front door, FLC/Sanctuary breezeway, Office/fellowship carport where the vans are usually kept. (You can stay in your vehicle to be checked or walk up for your temperature check. No entry allowed if your temperature is 100+ degrees.)
3. If you desire to worship in the Sanctuary you will wear a mask during your entire time inside! The entrance to the sanctuary will be through the doors to the back hallway on both sides. You will exit through the foyer door at the front of the building. The service will be live-streamed to the FLC if you would rather not wear a mask, though you are encouraged to do so.
4. Offering envelopes can be placed in specified containers as you enter or as you exit the worship service.
5. Inside services begin on NOVEMBER 1st at 10:50, and remember that day is also the "time change day" (fall back)
6. Please come a little early so that all will go smoothly. If you come after 10:45 you will need to go to the FLC live-stream location.
7. The pews available for seating are marked with a green cloth over the end arm. All others are marked by signs for non-use. Some are marked for families.
8. Our Health Team has worked very diligently to make this transition inside as safe as possible. Yes, it is strange and inconvenient, but so is COVID. Be patient and pray for a vaccine ASAP!
