**"Country Boy" to present program at
Men's Night**

**Tuesday, March 15, 2016 6:00pm Double
Springs Baptist Church Family Life Center**



Josh Hudson, who describes

himself as "just a country boy" will share his testimony at the Men's Night Tuesday, March 15th, at Double Springs.

His message through word and song are based on "family, faith, and farming," he says.

Growing up in a family of sharecroppers on the line between Burke and Cleveland counties, he learned farming the hard way, but he also learned about faith and family there, too. "My mother and grandmother took me to church," he says, "and taught me good Christian values."

The songs he writes, such as "Roots," are gospel descriptions of life close to the earth and the old-fashioned values he learned at home. "Ninety-five percent of what I write is biographical," he says, "but I want

everything to be connected to my Christian faith." His bluegrass style comes from what he calls his "musical pedigree" that began when his grandmother, who was an original member of the St. Paul Quartet in the 1940s, taught him the first three chords on a guitar when he was 10 years old.

Now at 35, he is making a career in the music business, from writing songs to performing to mastering the behind-the-scenes work of producing a CD.

Josh will be sharing his testimony by sharing stories that go along with his songs. "Music as an art is unique," he believes. "You can say a painting is worth a thousand words but a 3-minute song can take you back to a different place. It brings back memories. Just the first note of a song can take you back." The \$10 ticket includes dinner, which begins at 6 p.m., and the program.
